## **#1 DOG PARK INJURY**

The #1 dog park related injury is sprains and soft tissue injuries and a trip to the vet usually runs about \$200. This is usually caused by inactivity during the winter months. After just a matter of days of not being used, well conditioned muscles begin to lose their tone and strength.

Before you set off for the dog park for an intense workout it is a good idea to take your dog for a walk and encourage your dog to stretch his limbs.

It is important for your dog to get some exercise on a daily basis to help the muscles and ligaments stay healthy

and strong. This will help him avoid strains, sprains and other injuries during intense exercise.

One day while on a walk, she slipped out of the leash and took off heading south on Jennings. and friends Family searched the downtown neighborhoods relentlessly for her for 5 days. They posted Lost/ Found info everywhere including Facebook. They visited the shelter daily looking for her and were convinced that she took off to die, not wanting the family to see her do it.

Over a month later they got a phone call from the vet saying that someone found a German Shepherd on Rogers Street and brought her to their office. She's home!! Even though she is old. has cancer. needed daily medication and has been gone for over a month, she is home. She is okay. They are elated!! (This is the same German Shepherd

that jumped the fence about 5 years ago during a severe thunderstorm and was gone over 3 months when campers found her at Hulah Lake and called them as she was still wearing her collar/tags!

A testimonial to collar and tags. Even though this is a day of microchipping, we are sure there are plenty of people out there that would not even think to take a dog to a vet or someone like ARF or WCSPCA to check them with a scanner.

We don't hear enough happy endings, so we wanted to share this story with all of you.

You'll also be asked to provide your name, address phone number and credit card information.
